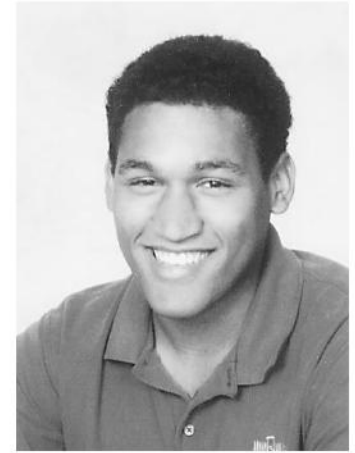

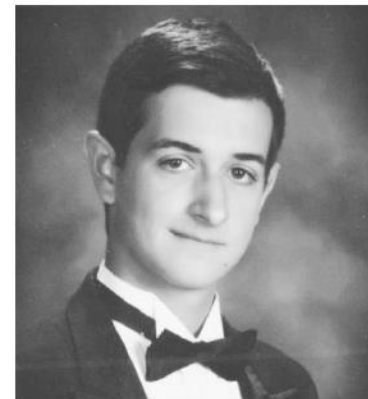

of North Florida Jazz Combo, and an accompanist at the University of North Florida.

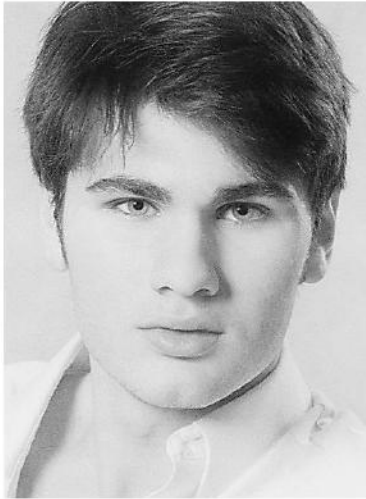
