### **Marianne C. Junker**

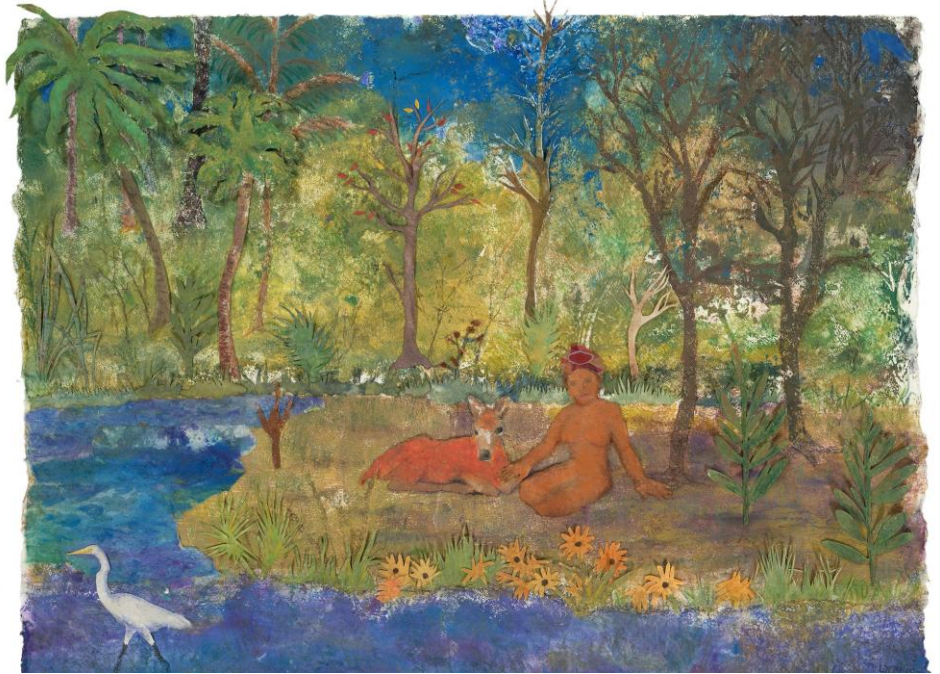
